The races include a Cape to Cape, 2, 7, & 12 mile races and others. The prize purse will be \$30,000!!






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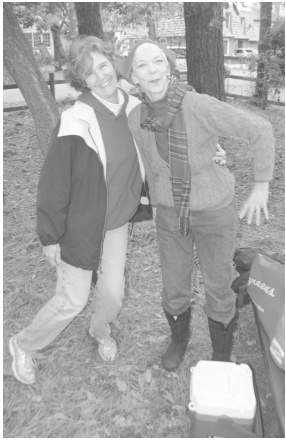

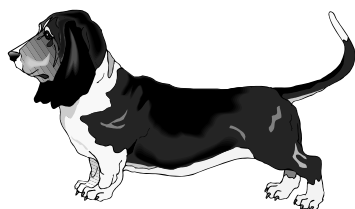
SPCA Donations
