Report/Highlights: Diana reminded everyone of the upcoming Virginia Beach Council of Civic Organizations (VBCCO) meeting. She also mentioned that the bulletin board in the park was vandalized with spray paint.

Committee Report Highlights:

- Neighborhood Watch (NW) Regina reported that a new group of individuals have been cruising the park but don't seem to be a problem. The bulletin board has been cleaned up, but has since been tagged again. Police on ATVs were seen along Cape Story beach the first week of May, nobody was sure of the reason.
- Spring Fling **Sunday 4PM to 7PM, May** 18th. Todd is chairing this event and needs help with set-up, cleanup and cooking. Everything is ready to go.
- Neighborhood Beautification Clean up day on April 27th was not well attended. We need more volunteers to help in the future. The ditch next to the path is stopped up. - Military Liaison Troops were welcomed with flags and signs. Actual arrival time was changed several times which prevented volunteers from being present along the roadside. Fireworks - Tracy stated that Matt Angelo has agreed to be Chairperson for 2009. Tosh also mentioned he knew of someone that may want to Co-Chair with Matt and would look into it. This could save Cape Story money on survey and permit.
