2nd VP: VBCCO June meeting featured speakers on High Speed Rail and Light Rail. Thelma Drake said there are 3 HSR projects working. The Tide Light Rail will be opening soon in Norfolk. Safety issues relating to the Tide are being discussed in schools and on commercials. VBCCO will hold its annual picnic on July 15th at Mt. Trashmore.

Committees:

Clean-Up – Sat June 25th Park Clean-up at 9am to support the 4th of July activities. Bring a rake and gloves. Sat July 16th will be the next Trail and Road clean-up. It was suggested to purchase road signs so we don't have to go to City complex every time. Todd will look into this.

Skipjack – Passed out, street captains have to deliver

Military Liasion – The base contact has left. Empsy and Andy are looking for a new contact at JEB.

July 4th Parade and Fireworks – The parade theme is "Out of this World". A leader for the Kazoo Band is needed. Mayor Sessoms will be the grand marshal. Old Business Highlights -

Marina Shores Dredge Station — Virginian-Pilot had an article online about the issue. At their June 14th meeting, City Council will vote on a resolution requesting the Beaches & Waterways Commission to perform a study for the city-wide dredging plan. Lynn Hume says the Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA) will be reviewing an appeal of the City Staff's decision that a dredge transfer station is acceptable use for residential zoning. Empsy and Dave Williams will contact Lynnhaven River Now to discuss the issues and to learn their position.

Oak Street Beach Access – Rocks on the beach access remain from the beach replenishment project and are exposed. Hazard and hard to walk on. Empsy was asked to contact Phill Cotter to sift or cover them.

Storm Water Issues – Todd will continue to work on City Engineers to install an isolation valve in the First Landing Lane system to prevent back surge during high tide storm events.

New Business Highlights -

Civic League Flags (Shore Drive)- We need a list of volunteers with a ladder that are willing to help cover 3-4 streets. Volunteers would put up and take down flags and identify when new flags are needed. 3 or 4 volunteers are needed.

Bicycle Safety on Shore Drive - City Council will hear bicycle advocates at their next meeting. It was suggested that someone should contact Fort Story base and see if they'd open up to bikers again. Empsy will look into.

Next Cape Story Meeting – No meetings over summer. Next meeting on Monday September 12th at 7:30pm in the VB Resort Hotel and Conference Center.
