Bayfront Communities Parking Survey

February 20, 2014

Introduction:

At the request of Bayfront Advisory Committee, Traffic Engineering staff has surveyed the Bayfront Communities north of Shore Drive between the Lesner Bridge and State Park, including Cape Story by the Sea community. The purpose of this parking survey was to locate the illegal no parking signs, misplaced signs, illegal encroachments, and those legal no parking signs that are no longer needed due to changes over the years in this area. The results of parking survey are listed in three categories:

Category I – The illegal No Parking signs that have been identified & removed.

Category II – The No Parking signs and encroachments that need further investigations & necessary actions as needed for their removal.

Category III – The Legal No parking signs that could be relocated or removed to provide additional on-street parking spaces.

Summary of Parking Survey:

<u>Category I:</u> Violation notices were issued & illegal No Parking signs were removed at following locations:

- I. 2741 Shore Drive near Maple Street
- II. 2596 Shore Drive near First Landing
- III. 2321 First Landing Lane
- IV. 2310 Bayberry Street

<u>Category II</u>: The following No Parking (N/P) signs and encroachments need further investigations & necessary actions as needed for their removal:

- I. The N/P sign at 2244 Walke Street.
- II. N/P signs to "N/P on Pavement" signs along the west side of First Landing Road.
- III. The N/P sign to "N/P on Pavement" sign at 2273 Calvert St.

- IV. The "N/P Private Driveway" sign at 2310 (A&B) Sandalwood Street.
- V. The encroachments in R.OW. at 2305 & 2306 Sandalwood Street.
- VI. The encroachment at 2300 Maple Street (private parking sign).
- VII. Misplaced N/P signs need to be removed along east side of 2200 block of Oak Street between Cape Henry Trail & 2244 Oak Street.
- VIII. Change N/P signs to "N/P on Pavement" along north side of Shore Drive between Kendall Street and Croix Drive.
- IX. Relocate & adjust N/P signs at 2253-2257 Oak Street.

<u>Category III</u>: The following legal N/P signs could be relocated or removed to provide approximately 25 legal on-street parking spaces in this area:

- I. Relocate the N/P to corner signs on both sides of W. Great Neck Road just south of Ocean Shore Avenue closure to Ocean Shore Ave.
- II. Remove "N/P on Pavement" sign on power pole on north side of Page Ave just west of Mooring Place.
- III. Remove "N/P" signs along south side of Page Ave across from Cape Henry Tower Condos
- IV. Adjust N/P signs on both sides of Page Avenue between the entrances to the Cape Henry Tower Condos & Cherry Tree Pl.
- V. Remove N/P signs on east side of Cherry Tree PI to open up parking just before the curve area.
- VI. Adjust the N/P signs on south side of Ocean Shore Ave across from Ocean Shore Cres (Condos).

Next Action:

- 1. Staff will complete the items in Category II within next 6-8 weeks weather permitting.
- 2. This report will be presented to BAC for their review & comments before taking any actions on items in Category III.
